Minutes from 1/4/12 Meeting

Attendees: Russ Curran, Louis Borges, Jr., Peg Enos, Kim Kilroy, Cheryl Dinneen, Gary Mendes, Kristen Brechter, Jim Watson, Bryan Klugh, Jeanne Quinn, Mary LeClair, Kevin Kilroy, Ken Lalli

Call to Order/Introductions: Russ Curran called the meeting to order; sign in sheet distributed; minutes from the 12/7/11 meeting submitted and approved without discussion.

Financial Report: Peg Enos reported a balance of \$17,526.31. Most invoices from fall expenses paid. Final payment is due to Piesco for some last minute items for school store. Football concessions adjusted to \$3200 after last payments for supplies. Report submitted and approved without discussion.

CCAA Store: Store hours for winter are Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 1:30 to 3:30 p.m. and during any home basketball game. Store will be open for Winter Open House and Accepted Students Night.

Concessions: Basketball concessions underway. Deposit of \$206 thus far.

Athletic Director's Report: Prior to Coach Pileski's late arrival (hockey game), Dr. Tranter spoke on his behalf. Coach Pileski thanked the CCAA for fall concessions and the school store stock/staffing. New store merchandise has sold well. Coach also felt that the previously noted quality and success of the combined boys' and girls' soccer banquet made for a strong recommendation to require this model of all sports teams. Motion made, seconded, and approved that the Coyle and Cassidy Athletic Association, along with the Coyle and Cassidy High School Administration, require that all standard sports team banquets be held at CCHS.

School President's Report: Dr. Tranter reported that the Coyle and Cassidy Athletic Hall of Fame Committee had been revived and had been meeting. Their purpose is to recognize exceptional talent/achievement by CCHS athletes. An April induction ceremony is being planned. Referencing the batting "turtle" from the December meeting,

Dr. Tranter also reminded that CCAA that major financial expenditures require the approval of the Athletic Director and School President. Russ Curran noted that this was understood and that the CCAA had only voted and approved to solicit bids for the item for future consideration. Bryan Klugh also noted that the newly adopted CCAA By-laws clearly outline these financial parameters.

Old Business: Polar Bear menu finalized. Peg to send \$1500 check to Sirois Catering for deposit. Volunteers needed for set-up and clean up on January 28th. Quality Beverage still needs request submitted on CCHS letterhead with tax ID information for donation of 3 kegs of beer. Baskets expected from each sports team for raffle purposes. Coach Lalli returned to review and further explain his need for a batting “turtle” for the baseball team. Some discussion as to storage and additional usage. Motion made, seconded, and approved to purchase equipment for \$3072 from Collegiate Pacific.

New Business: Weight room discussion tabled until February meeting. Paquin Scholarship Fund at \$1267. Not awarded last year. Discussion for additional funding tabled. Special meeting to finalize Polar Bear scheduled for Thursday, January 19th at 7 p.m.
