**Minutes from 12/7/11 Meeting**

**Call to Order/Introductions:** Russ Curran called the meeting to order; sign in sheet distributed; minutes from the 11/2/11 meeting submitted and approved without discussion.

**Financial Report:** Peg Enos reported a balance of \$17,526.31. Last invoices paid were to vendors for CCAA store stock. Football concessions netted about \$3500 for season. Some outstanding bills include Kerry Tranter and Peg Enos for supplies.

**CCAA Store:** New stock selling well. Sales for November were approximately \$2000. Store is staffed through Christmas. New hours will be arranged at the meeting on January 4, 2012. Store will be open during all home basketball games for girls and possibly, boys as well. Sign will be placed at concessions table and on door to indicate that store can be opened for purchases.

**Concessions:** Basketball concessions underway. Kevin Kilroy will coordinate stock levels and girls coverage. Russ Curran will coordinate boys coverage. Cash box will be stored with Coach Pileski. Both Boys and Girls parents will be asked to contribute one case of water to concessions. Pizza will be ordered through B&F. Price increased to \$2 per slice.

**Athletic Director's Report:** None

**School President's Report:** None Peg Enos did pass on a message from Dr. Tranter that she was very pleased with the outcome of the combined Girls and Boys Soccer banquet. The event was held in the CCHS cafeteria and catered by Kerry Tranter. Dr. Tranter thought it could represent a model to be considered for all sports teams.

**Old Business:** Polar Bear date to remain as planned. Band, caterer, Sure Shot Promotions all confirmed. CCAA is requesting that each athletic team donate a basket for raffle table at Polar Bear. The following people have been designated to coordinate the process for their team: Boys and Girls Soccer- Mary McGonigle, Hockey- Josie Perry, Cheerleaders – Beth Gracia, Girls Basketball- Kim Kilroy, Football- Kristen Brechter, Golf- Mrs. Borges, Volleyball-Jeanne Quinn, Softball-Mary LeClair and Heidi Gaboula, Baseball-Danielle Curran, Boys Basketball-Cindy Bernard, Lacrosse-Randy Gasbarro, Swim – Ken Lalli. Cross Country and Track have no designee as of now. Tickets will be available at all basketball concessions, from any CCAA board member, and at the CCHS office. As per past policy, reserved tables must be prepaid in full.

**New Business:** Coach Lalli submitted a request for a batting cage coined a “turtle” to prevent not only loss of balls, but ensure safety of athletes sent in woods to retrieve balls and track athletes running in the area during batting practice. Old unit no longer usable due to wear and tear. Approximate cost is \$3500. MUCH discussion as to possible price and storage, etc. Some inquiry as to whether unit could be shared with softball team and their set-up for batting practice. CCAA general membership voted to solicit bids for requested item. Beth Gracia submitted a request from Coach O’Brien for 4 new Girls basketballs and a Slip-Not sticky pad unit. Discussion ensued as to whether or not this request (basketballs only) was appropriate to CCAA. Many felt that basketballs should be considered necessary equipment and therefore, a part of the Athletic Director’s budget and funds. Since Coach Pileski was not in attendance, CCAA general membership voted to approve \$350 in funds for Coach O’Brien’s discretionary use IF the basketballs were not a part of Athletic Funds. One member was in opposition to the vote.
