**Minutes from 10/5/11 Meeting**

**Attendees:** Tom Pileski, Russ Curran, Louis Borges, Jr., Peg Enos, Kim Kilroy, Bryan Klugh, Peter Ferreira, Michaelle Rosen, Randy Gasbarro, Beth Gracia, Mary LeClair, Jeanne Quinn

**Call to Order/Introductions:** Immediately following the general Coyle and Cassidy Parents Association meeting Russ Curran called the CCAA meeting to order; sign in sheet distributed; minutes from the 6/8/11 meeting submitted and approved without discussion.

**Financial Report:** Peg Enos reported a balance of \$16,156.83. Recent expenses include \$173 for concession stand grill, \$470 for Meet and Greet, \$3744 for football prepaid items and girls basketball jackets, and \$872 for volleyball Breast Cancer match. Some discussion occurred around the \$200 expense for Martha's Vineyard football food expense. Coach Pileski stated that we reciprocated as they fed our athletes. He did state, however, that he would clarify last year's position that each school would provide for their own student-athletes at the next Athletic Director's meeting for the Eastern Athletic Conference. No major expenses remain except ongoing supplies for football concession stand. Russ Curran inquired as to status of CD and was informed by Dr. Tranter that it is in a "day to day" rollover status. Motion to accept Treasurer's Report seconded and approved with discussions noted above.

**CCAA Store:** Store receipts of \$3769. Peg Enos and Michelle Rosen have been staffing store after school. Kim Kilroy to work one Saturday a month for now. Discussion held as to permanent store hours (especially during holiday season). Tuesday and Thursday from 2:00 to 3:30 p.m. and Saturdays from 9 to 11 a.m. would be ideal; CCAA unable to commit to these hours until volunteers available. Biggest issue continues to be lack of store chairperson to oversee buying and coordinate store hours and sales. Dr. Tranter again expressed concern as lack of process to ensure uniformity of school store items and "branding" of school apparel. All purchases for team apparel (including pre-sales) as well as school store should conform to Warrior logo and color scheme. She also suggested the CCAA create a standard bid process and order form for all school apparel.

**Concessions:** Football concessions underway. Receipts of \$1093 for food and \$459 for 50/50 raffle thus far. Thanksgiving Day game volunteers will need to be addressed at next meeting.

**Athletic Director's Report:** Coach Pileski stated that all Coyle and Cassidy High School athletic programs continue to enjoy the full support of the school community. Some discussion held regarding misinterpretation of recent charity hockey game and Stanley Cup viewing. While some proceeds from that event will go into the CCHS President's Fund, it was not a CCHS funded event and is not intended to suggest that each sports team at CCHS is free to raise funds independently. Dr. Tranter made it clear that any "directed giving" monies, while accepted, are not to be solicited. Such bequests are held in account by her office until spending decisions are made by the school President, Athletic Director, and coach. Coach Pileski also reported that a new weight room/wellness center and new general locker room are current department goals.

**School President's Report:** Debt from addition in 1997 was paid in June should free up funds for much-needed science department addition and upgrades as well as weight room. Publication of fall sports program completed. CCAA will receive proceeds from advertisers. Some discussion on having CCAA members help to solicit ads for future programs (winter, spring). Dr. Tranter also reiterated that each sports team should have representation at CCAA monthly meetings to ensure that team needs/requests are met.

**Old Business:** Volleyball Breast Cancer Awareness Match will be held October 22<sup>nd</sup>, team parents requested support of CCAA general membership. Extra tee shirts were ordered and will be made available to public. Concessions/bake sale to be coordinated by team. Girls' basketball jackets received and distributed to team members.

**New Business:** Polar Bear date set for January 28<sup>th</sup>; Russ to call Sirois Catering and Too Much Fun to confirm date and price for services. Silent auction items will be solicited in December. Russ will also be contacting the President of the Taunton High School Athletic Association Gridiron Club to inquire as to what cooking equipment will be available to us and how many volunteers it takes to staff the concessions for the Thanksgiving Day game.
