April 7, 2010 – Meeting Minutes

Attendees: Marianne MacLeod, Tom Pileski, Kim Kilroy, Kevin Kilroy, Danielle Curran, Russ Curran, Peggy Enos, Lynn Petrowski, Bryan Klugh, Robert Carroll.

Secretary's Report: Meeting minutes are on the website. Unfortunately, we did not have a copy of last month's meeting minutes to review.

Treasurer's Report: Marianne MacLeod, gave an update on the financials for CCAA. There was little activity with the treasury, except for the invoices for lacrosse equipment that Mrs. Metzger paid. Marianne will be meeting with Mrs. Metzger to go over the account and will have an update at the next meeting.

The recap of the basketball concession showed that \$840 was the net made for the entire season at the boy's and girl's games. This amount was after purchasing pizza and water for the Martha's Vineyard teams when they played at Coyle. Once again Kim & Kevin Kilroy were thanked for taking over the concessions for this season.

CCAA Store: Sheila Medeiros was unable to attend tonight's meeting. Nothing new to report regarding the store. It is very slow this time of year. Russ will contact Kevin & Sheila to go over everything with them.

Russ has contacted a company to give us a price for flip flops similar to the ones shown on the information sheets Marianne brought to last month's meeting. These would be sold at the store.

Athletic Director's Report:

Lacrosse: Mr. Pileski reported that the lacrosse teams have started their season and will be playing the games at Hopewell Park under the lights. Expenses incurred for the start-up of the boy's and girl's team amount to approximately \$9,000. Mr. Pileski asked the CCAA to pick up the cost for transportation and officials for the remainder of this season – approximately \$7,000. Motion was made, 2nd, and approved.

Mr. Pileski also informed the CCAA that next year's athletics budget will be level-funded and he may need to come to CCAA for additional monies.

April 7, 2010 – Meeting Minutes (Continued)

Equipment Purchase: A proposal for a new screen to groom the baseball and softball fields was brought in front of the CCAA. The total cost would be \$349.00. Russ Curran said the screen is being used and the invoice can be paid. Marianne will take care of paying the invoice.

Coaches – discussion was held regarding inviting all coaches to a special meeting to introduce them to CCAA, explain what we do and to give them an opportunity to submit requests to CCAA. This subject will be revisited at the next meeting. Possibly something could be held late summer/early September.

Hall of Fame – Mr. Pileski touched upon possibly in the future having some type of Hall of Fame for Coyle Athletics. Information going back many years will need to be compiled. This would be a great opportunity to recognize milestones of coaches and athletes.

Recognition – Members approved the purchase of a plaque honoring Coach Mike O'Brien's 100th win with the girl's basketball team. This plaque will be presented at the varsity girl's first home game in the 2010-2011 season.

By-Laws – A copy of the current by-laws was handed out to all in attendance. These are from 2008 and will need to be reviewed and updated. One addition will need to be made regarding a formal recognition program. This will be revisited at the next meeting and will most likely be handled by the incoming Board.

Volunteers – Discussion was held regarding ways to get more parents involved and to get volunteers to help out. All sports teams should have at least one parent representative at each meeting. The first meeting of the year in August will be the cookout and meeting the coaches evening for parents of athletes.
